Her One and Only: Child abuse (in the past), stalker and exchange of gunfire in crowded public place, gunshot injury, secondary characters face frightening situation with their pregnancy that turns out well (in the story)

A Love Like Ours: an IED explosion while serving overseas in the military (in the past), PTSD, a sibling seriously ill from complications of cerebral palsy, secondary characters dealing with infertility (in the story)

Meant to Be Mine: unplanned pregnancy (in the past), single parenting, knee injury, mention of secondary characters dealing with infertility (in the story)

Undeniably Yours: abandonment by husband and divorce (in the past), anxiety, a fist fight, and a hostage situation (in the story)
